Application and registration fees are determined and approved by the Council members of the College of Dietitians of Prince Edward Island.

PROCEDURE

1. Registration fees are due yearly for renewing members. Full payment of appropriate registration fees is required for registration renewal.
2. Applicants are required to pay the registration fee and an application fee. Applicants include new applicants to the College and previous members who resigned from the College and are re-applying for membership.
3. Application fee for new graduates from a EQUAL accredited program or those who are registered in another Canadian jurisdiction is \$50.00.
3. Applicants that require further assessment from the Registration Committee will need to pay an assessment fee:
 - a. Application assessment for internationally educated applicants: \$185.00
 - b. Application assessment for Canadian educated currency applicants: \$300.00
 - c. Competence assessment for currency upgrading applicants: \$200.00
4. Annual registration fees will be processed on receipt of total payment.
 - a. For the registration year of April 1, 2023-March 31, 2024: \$350.00
 - b. For the registration of ½ year or part thereof October 1, 2021-March 31, 2022: \$235.00
 - c. For the registration of ¼ year or part thereof January 1, 2022-March 31, 2022: \$118.00
 - d. For the registration of full year of part thereof for Dietitian Candidate: \$175.00
5. Special Registration*
 - a. Special Registration Application Fee: \$50.00
 - b. Special Registration Practice Fee: \$60.00 per month (maximum of 120 consecutive days)

**Regulated Health Professionals Act*

13. Special registration (1) Notwithstanding section 12, a person who is authorized by a professional regulatory body in another jurisdiction recognized by a council to (a) practise a regulated health profession; or (b) use a title relating to the practice of the regulated health profession, may apply to the council, in a form approved by the council, to be registered in the register of the regulated health profession for a limited time or for a special purpose.
