

## **Publicly Accessible Dietitian Services**

Registered Dietitians and Nutritionists work in a variety of settings. Here are some ideas for locating a Registered Dietitian or Nutritionist in your area:

- Ask your health care provider for a referral to a Registered Dietitian or Nutritionist
- If you do not have a health care provider you can request a referral through:
